

# BJP leader Yeddyurappa sworn in as Karnataka CM

Bangaluru, May 17,

The BJP legislative party leader B S Yeddyurappa was sworn in as the 24th Chief Minister of Karnataka today. Governor Vajubhai Vala administered the oath of office to him. He took oath in the name of God and farmers. Senior BJP leaders Ananth Kumar, Prakash Javdekar, Dharmendra Pradhan, J P Nadda and all the newly elected MLAs of BJP were present on the occasion. Addressing media persons after assuming office, Yeddyurappa said MLAs who respect people's mandate will vote for him during the floor test and said he seeks conscience vote of all the members of the Assembly. On fulfilling the promise of waiving loans of up to one lakh of all the farmers and weavers, he said Chief Secretary has sought time till tomorrow to collate the information on the loan amount that needs to be waived off and once the information is provided, he said, he will take a decision on the waiver. Saying that the issue of Government formation is in



Supreme Court and hence he said, he cannot elaborate further on how he seeks to garner necessary numbers. On the other side, the Janata Dal (Secular) State President H D Kumaraswamy has made an appeal to the leaders of various non-BJP political parties including Mamata Banerjee and Mayawati to register their protest against BJP attempts to form Government in Karnataka. Speaking to media persons in Bengaluru today, he said that the Modi Government is using threats and other means to force Congress and JD(S) MLAs to defect to their side. He expressed objection

to the 15 days given by the Governor to BJP to prove majority. He later joined the Congress leaders in front of Mahatma Gandhi statue to be part of the protest. Speaking to media persons on the sidelines of protest, former Chief Minister Siddaramaiah said Supreme Court has asked BJP to submit list of MLAs supporting them and the legal fight will be continued by the Congress. He blamed BJP for usurping power even when in minority. Early this morning, the Supreme Court refused to stay the swearing-in of BJP leader BS Yeddyurappa as

like BJP. The court also issued a notice to respondents including BJP and asked them to file their replies. The Supreme Court was hearing a petition filed Congress and JD(S) seeking to stay the swearing-in ceremony of Mr Yeddyurappa. BJP President Amit Shah has congratulated BS Yeddyurappa for being sworn in as the Chief Minister of Karnataka. In a tweet, Mr Shah said this is the victory of every Kannadiga who voted to uproot the corrupt and divisive politics of Congress. He expressed confidence that the new government under the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi will fulfil the aspirations of the people. Information and Broadcasting Minister Rajyavardhan Rathore also extended his greetings to Mr Yeddyurappa. In a tweet, he said the state will tread on a new path of development, growth, progress and prosperity under the leadership of the new Chief Minister.

## PM Modi to address national executives of all BJP wings today

The party leadership is likely to use the opportunity to set the agenda in the run-up to the next Lok Sabha polls, which is about a year away, and exhort the party executives to use their organisational machinery to share the central government's successes with the masses.

## CBI arrests 2 UP police sub-inspectors in Unnao rape case

The CBI today arrested two sub-inspectors of the Uttar Pradesh Police in connection with the reported death of the father of a minor girl, who was allegedly raped by BJP MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar at Unnao, in judicial custody. The victim's father was booked by the police under the Arms Act on 3rd of April this year and put in jail on 5th of April.

The CBI officials said, Sub Inspector Ashok Singh Bhadauriya, the then Station Officer and Sub Inspector Kamta Prasad Singh—both of Police Station Makhli in Unnao district have been arrested in the case. The duo is at present under suspension. They said the accused will be produced before the competent court tomorrow. The officials said. The two have been arrested over allegations of criminal conspiracy and destruction of evidence. The rape victim had alleged that she was raped by the MLA at his residence on June 4, 2017 where she had gone with a relative seeking a job.

## Ram Jethmalani moves SC against Karnataka Gov's decision inviting BJP to form govt

The Supreme Court will hear tomorrow Senior lawyer and jurist Ram Jethmalani's plea against the Karnataka Governor's decision to invite the BJP to form government in the state. Considering the submission of Jethmalani seeking an urgent hearing, a bench

headed by Chief Justice Dipak Misra today said that a three-judge special bench, which had heard the matter in the early hours, would hear the matter tomorrow. In his plea Jethmalani said, he has not come before the court in favour or against any party but has been hurt over the unconstitutional decision taken by the Governor.

## Nagaland board higher secondary Class 10th examination results 2018 to be declared tomorrow on nbsenagaland.com

Kohima, May 17,

The Nagaland Board of School Education (NBSE) will announce its Class 10th board examination results tomorrow (18th May). Eligible students who appeared for the exams may check their results on the official board website, [nbsenagaland.com](http://nbsenagaland.com). In addition to this, the results will also be declared on [examresults.net](http://examresults.net) and [indiaresults.com](http://indiaresults.com) on Friday afternoon. A report on *The Indian Express* said 10,437 boys and 11,275 girls had registered for the HSLC (High School Leaving Certificate) from 78 centres. The highest enrolment was observed at Dimapur district with 7,094 candidates followed by Kohima with 3,619 candidates,

the report said. The High School Leaving Certificate or the Class 10th examinations started on 15 February and ended on 27 February. Some 22,446 students appeared in the examination that was held despite wide protests by the Nagaland Tribes Action Committee (NTAC), Kohima and the Joint Coordination Committee (JCC).

## Pakistan court shoots down petitions seeking Nawaz Sharif's trial under treason charges for Mumbai attack remarks

A Pakistani court on Thursday dismissed three petitions seeking trial of ousted prime minister Nawaz Sharif under treason charges for his statement on the 2008 Mumbai terror attack, declaring them "non-maintainable". In an interview last week, the three-time premier had questioned Pakistan's policy to allow the "non-state actors" to cross the border and "kill" people in Mumbai as he publicly acknowledged that terrorist groups are active in the country. His comments triggered a major controversy, inviting criticism from all quarters. The National Security Committee, Pakistan's top civil-military body, condemned the "fallacious" statement by Sharif about the Mumbai terror attack and termed it as "incorrect and misleading". Lahore High Court Justice Shams Mahmood Mirza dismissed three petitions filed by opposition Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf (PTI) and Pakistani Awami Tehreek (PAT) and rights activist advocate Abdullah Malik. After hearing arguments of the petitioners, Justice Mirza declared them "non-maintainable". The petitioners contended that Sharif tarnished the country's image. Sharif, 68, is already being tried in three corruption cases in the Panama Papers scandal in which he is accused of buying properties in the UK through corruption. "The statement by the former premier benefited India and appeared prejudiced towards the state's safety and the

interests, and that apparently Sharif is guilty of high treason as well as offences punishable in terms of the Official Secret Act, 1923 for which he deserves to be proceeded in accordance with law," the petitioners said. They pleaded the statement of Sharif amounts to "committing treason" against the country. The opposition parties moved the court on Sharif's interview to Dawn on May 12 in which he had stated: "terrorist organisations are active. "Call them non-state actors, should we allow them to cross the border and kill 150 people in Mumbai? Explain it to me. Why can't we complete the trial? We have isolated ourselves. Despite giving sacrifices, our narrative is not being accepted. Afghanistan's narrative is being accepted, but ours is not. We must look into it". Resolutions against Sharif have also been brought in the country's three provincial assemblies demanding registration of a treason case against him for his controversial remarks on the 2008 Mumbai attacks. In one such resolution, opposition PTI also demanded "hang Nawaz Sharif being a traitor". In addition to this, two applications have been filed in Lahore's police stations seeking registration of FIRs against Sharif. Ten Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) terrorists killed 166 people and wounded dozens in Mumbai in November, 2008. Nine of the attackers were killed by police while lone survivor Ajmal Kasab was caught. Kasab was executed after a court found him guilty and handed down the death sentence.
