yesterday sentenced Suresh to life imprisonment under provisions of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO).

The judge also sentenced him to 10 years rigorous imprisonment for kidnapping the girl and two years RI under the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act. The judge ordered that the sentences should run concurrently.


