## Bomb threats to JNIMS Director

**Imphal, July 13:** Unknown persons placed a hand grenade at the residence of Dr. Laishram Deben, Director of Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Science (JNIMS) at Kakwa Ashem Leikai under Singjamei police station. The hand grenade was found by family members at around 6 am today morning. A team of police bomb disposal squad retrieved the hand grenade at around 6.30 am. So far no group has called responsibility.

This is the second tie that unknown persons placed hand grenade at the residence of JNIMS director. Earlier too, on January 4 this year, unknown person placed a live lethod shell at his residence. Later, armed group Maoist Communist Party had claimed responsibility to the placing of the lethod shell saying it as a warning.

## Biker died in self accident

Cause of the accident is yet to be confirmed. A police team who rushed the site picked the dead body and deposited at RIMS morgue.

## Motivation of teachers, constant evaluation key to progress of School Education : N. Praveen, Director

**Imphal, July 13:** The Manipur Education (S) department is planning to overhaul the school education system and improve level of teaching and students according to N. Praveen, Director, Education (S) department, Government of Manipur while addressing the press conference at the DIPR Manipur premises here today. The results of the activities taken up by the government will take some time to be visibly seen however the shortage of teachers faced by the department has been filled up gradually. He further said the teachers were facing problems related to promotion and other matters which affected the teaching hence a comprehensive programme has been initiated to motivate the teachers. The Directorate has thirteen zonal

education offices, six in hill and seven in valley districts.

There are seven offices of the Deputy Inspector of Schools - two in valley (Moirang&Lilong) and five in hills(Saikul, Moreh, SaituGamphajol, Henglep and Tamei) which are functioning more or less independently.

The Department provides cooked food under Mid-Day-Meal Scheme with emphasis on providing nutritional support to the children in Primary and Upper Primary Schools. To provide quality education programmes under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan is taken up as envisaged by the RTE Act.

It is continuing implementation of RMSA to continue efforts to achieve universalisation of secondary education by 2017 and full retention by 2020. The department works to create ICT assets and

pilot e-governance plans to promote transparency and delivery of service.

The scheme has covered 2475 Primary, 717 Upper Primary attached with Primary and 177 Upper Primary without Primary Schools were covered till the end of December, 2015.

Random and surprise inspections carried out by the State MDM Team has enabled implementation of Mid-Day Meal scheme effectively. Disciplinary proceedings have been initiated against those teachers who failed to serve regular meals under the scheme.

To inculcate scientific temper and to create awareness of the rapid developments taking place in science, the Science Unit conducts Science Seminar, Examinations, State Level National Talent Search Examination, 2015 (for class X).

## JAC of Md Naoshad Khan demand justice

**Imphal, July 13:** JAC against the brutal killing of Md Naoshad Khan today demanded immediate punishment of those responsible in the killing. Speaking to the media persons at Manipur Press Club, Aribam Aziz Khan, Co-Convenor of the JAC said that the main accused Md Nasir Khan of the killing of

Md Naoshad Khan who was granted bail on July 5 has been arrested again on July 12 by a team of Lilong Police led by Lilong OC Bangabihari from Pangei Haotal area while the other accused Md Sajish Alam who was sent to jail only for 38 days and later given bail is on the run.

As no accused are booked, the JAC appealed the

concern authority to look into the case once again to bring justice to the deceased family.

The JAC further condemn the former OC of Imphal East for not taking serious to the case.

Md Naoshad Khan was found dead on April 2, 2015 at around 6 am inside his car with marks of brutally assault and bullet injury at his head.

**Imphal, July 13:** Two men proclaiming to be representatives of Travel Terminal, a tour operator based in Bengaluru have approached a school in Imphal claiming that students would be taken for a trip to Kennedy Space Centre in the United States of America. The tour operator claimed to have approached other schools in Imphal too to mobilise students.

Fees of the 12 days tour to United states as mentioned in the brochure is Rupees 2,30,000 (two lakh thirty thousand) departure from Kolkata excluding Imphal Kolkata Imphal fares, hotels for VISA and interviews, Imphal Kolkata Imphal onward and return fare and charges for Indian Passport. Eligibility as stated in their brochure is for students studying from class V to XII, BA/BSc with the approval of parents.

Manipur has regularly been from time to time rocked by money laundering scandals. Different form of schemes have been used by the swindlers to deceive the hard earned money of the common man in recent few years, crores of rupees have been swindled from the state.

Surprisingly the brochure distributed by an agency organising tour to the United States is just a simple printing on a plain A4 paper with no letterheads and the distributed brochures are photocopied one with hand written website

and emails of their parent office - [www.travelterminal.biz](http://www.travelterminal.biz) and an email - [srinivas@travelterminal.biz](mailto:srinivas@travelterminal.biz)! On visiting the website the same email - [srinivas@travelterminal.biz](mailto:srinivas@travelterminal.biz) was found, travel terminal's mobile number 9902765188 is a number that does not exist and not working. Details of the ownership of the domain [www.travelterminal.biz](http://www.travelterminal.biz) is one M Krishna of Lakshimpuram Layout, Bangalore 560097 and on ringing his mobile number 9632042971 submitted at the time of registration of domain, one Younis picked up the call. It is surprising how the two representatives, Joshua Daniel Rungtung, general manager, Overseas, Terminal Holy Tours private Ltd, and Nunglum Wungkhai, Director, Indo Myanmar Border Mission Printed their names in the brochures that they are MANIPUR CONTACT of Travel Terminal?

They had claimed in their brochure names a list of schools that had a successful trip last year. The list of schools includes 7 schools from Bangalore, 1 from New Delhi and 1 from Mangalore. Bishop Cotton School, listed in the brochures distributed by the duo, on being enquired if any of their students went for USA trip replied positive but to utter surprise, the trip which Bishop cotton school was not through Travel terminal.

If the claims of Travel

Terminal were true that they had successfully conducted trips to USA as is in their list in the brochure, where is the trip of 9 schools highlighted in their website? The website, according to domain registrar was last updated on Fri, Dec 18 2015 at 12:04:05pm IST.

In another surprise manner, test was conducted at COMET school to select students for the US trip on 12th of July and school authorities notified parents of the children who succeeded in the test conducted by the duo Josshua Daniel Rungtung and Nunglum Wungkhai to meet them. It is not known how many schools have been approached by the two in Imphal city alone?

The Deputy Speaker of Manipur Legislative Assembly had further certified that "Travel Terminal" headed by Joshua Daniel Rungtung and Nunglum Wungkhai are known for their relentless works for the betterment of the society dated 11th July 2016 but it is surprising how he endorsed the trip conducted by the duo. Even stating that "Necessary VISA for 10 years to USA will be arranged to each and every participant of this programme by the organiser"? Does the deputy speaker ever know what a task it is to get a VISA to USA and on what basis did he ensure in his certificate that VISA would be arranged to every participant by the organiser? Isn't it time we look back and think about the financial losses incurred by the people of the state by the swindlers?

## SC restores Cong government in Arunachal Pradesh

**New Delhi, July 13:** In a major setback to BJP and the government headed by it at the Centre, the Supreme Court today ordered restoration of the Congress government in Arunachal Pradesh by quashing all decisions of the Governor that had precipitated its fall in January, holding them "violative" of the Constitution.

The apex court's verdict came as a shot in the arm for the Congress, paving the way for the return of its dismissed government headed by Nabam Tuki.

The landmark unanimous judgement by a five-judge bench set aside among other things Governor Jyoti Prasad Rajkhowa's message directing the preponing of the session and the manner of holding the proceedings of sixth session of the Assembly scheduled from January 14, 2016, to December 16-18, 2015.

The constitution bench, headed by Justice J S Khehar, ordered that status quo ante as prevailed on December 15, 2015 be restored in Arunachal Pradesh Assembly.

This is the second major blow for the Centre from the Supreme Court which had only in May ordered a fresh floor test in Uttarakhnad Assembly that led to the return of the Congress

government headed by Harish Rawat and lifting of the President's Rule imposed on March 27.

Reading out the operative portions of the main judgement, Justice Khehar said the order of the Governor dated December 9, 2015, preponing the session of Legislative Assembly from January 14, 2016, to December 16, 2015, is violative of Article 163 read with Article 174 of the Constitution and as such is liable to be quashed and the same is quashed.

"Secondly, the message of governor directing the manner of conducting the proceedings of the sixth session of Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh from December 16-18, 2015, is violative of Article 163 read with Article 175 of the Constitution and as such is liable to be quashed and the same is quashed," the bench said.

Thirdly, the bench said "all steps and decisions taken by the Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh in pursuant to Governor's order of December 9, 2015, are unsustainable and liable to be set aside and as such it is set aside."

Finally, the bench observed, "In view of the decision from one to three, status quo ante as it prevailed on December 15, 2015, is ordered to be restored."
