Imphal, June 12: Armed group Kangleipak Communist Party (KCP) Poirei meitei Lup today said that the arrest of 5 KSA volunteers for checking adulteration of Tata Salt, an edible item and letting free of those involved in the adulteration of the edible food item is nothing but to conceal the truth about the appointment of 9 staffs who did not fulfilled the RR for appointment to the post by Okram Ibobi Sing led Congress Government.

In a press statement, Publicity Secretary of the outfit, Malemnganba Meetei said that, the five KSA volunteers were arrested to conceal the truth and protect the 9 staffs who had been appointed as Food Safety Officers at the Directorate of health Services Manipur by violating the RB Minister Okram Ibobi Singh is collecting huge amount of money from those traders responsible to the adulteration of the edible food items.
