against the perpetrators. In the backdrop of cases of assault on African nationals and outrage by envoys of African countries over killing of a Congolese youth, External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj

today spoke to Singh and Lieutenant Governor of Delhi Najeeb Jung to ensure safety of the community and strict action against the guilty. "Spoke to Commissioner of Police. Delhi regarding the

Minister said in a tweet after the meeting with Verma. He asked Delhi Police to increase patrolling in areas inhabited by African nationals and ensure their security.
