

BJP re-iterated stands on National Sports University construction; says Koutruk is the best location

Imphal, Oct 14: Convenor of the Election Committee, BJP Manipur Pradesh, Thounaojam Chaoba today sent strong message to the government of Manipur saying that the party will put all effort to stop construction of National Sports University at Yaitibi Loukon in Thoubal district.

Talking at the one day political conference for BJP workers a 21- Naoriya Pakhang Lakpa Mandal at Langthabal Phuramakhong, the former president of BJP and still continue to remain as strong man of the Right wing party Manipur Chapter, Th. Chaoba said that he could not find any logical justification for choosing the Cultivable Agricultural land that too by spending huge amount of state fund at a time when the state is facing acute shortage fund.

The former Union Minister of State is referring to the peoples' plea to establish the Sports University near Koutruk at which locals of the area are ready to donate the land at free of cost.

On the other hand, Th. Chaoba also said that the BJP will not allow any violation of human rights as well as international agreement signed by India to protect the cultivable land as well as forest area.

MLA Khumukcham Joykishan who also spoke on the occasion lambasted the state government for punishing those government officials who are rendering their duty with sincerity. Joykishan called on how Inspector Ranjit was

victimised after he hauled by large quantity of narcotic drugs as the owners or those involved in the drug rackets happen to be close relatives of the Chief Minister Okram Ibobi. BJP state vice president M. Ashikumar Singh,

spokesperson N. Mangi, along with three aspirant candidates of Naoriya Phakhanglakpa Assembly Constituency including N Manoranjan, O Malesh and E Subash attended the political conference as dignitaries.

Manipur Maoist to observe Black Day on Oct 15; boycotts Congress

Imphal, Oct 14: Maoist Communist Party Manipur (MCPM) has appealed the people of the state to observe October 15 as Black Day to protest the force merger of Manipur to the Indian Union. The armed rebel group also declare boycott to Congress party while observing Black Day.

In a press communiqué, the rebel group said that the Congress Party, a group of feudal and Comprador was brought forth by the British and developed them by the Indian colonialist to divert and derail the anti-feudal and anti-Imperialist national liberation movement which was led by Comrade Hijam Irabot and to deprived the people of revolutionary leadership. In a lengthy press

communiqué, Maoist stated that after the formal declaration of Manipur Merger Agreement, The Indian colonialist transferred the power to their faithful agents, the leadership of the Congress Party, representing the comprador bureaucratic Bourgeois and went behind the curtain. It may be mentioned that the Congress Party was the only party which conspired with Imperialist India to colonized Manipur so that they become Ruling class at then.

BJP's M Ashinikumkar's clarification on NH-37

NH 37 Imphal Jiribam portion which is life line of Manipur remains in pathetic condition inspite of one & half decade long congress regime in Manipur of which congress rule at the centre for one decade (2002-2014).

The irony is that the Ibbi led congress spends huge some of money under different head of accounts like ACA, SPAN, LCR, CRF, NEC, 12th & 13th Finance Commission Award, state plan etc to upgrade and maintain the national highways. Imphal to Pallel portion at international standard whereas the other important roads like Imphal - Jiribam, Imphal - Dimapur, Imphal - Ukhrul, Imphal - Moreh, Pallel-Chandel Imphal -CCpur via Moirang etc are pathetic

Prime minister Narendra Modi realizing the importance of Imphal Jiribam Highways announced that this upgradation of Imphal Jiri highway would initiated over a period of 100 days. Since congress govt is very in place in Manipur, the state govt should have taken initiative to get the highway upgraded with assistance from the central govt.

In Short, it is primary responsibility of congress govt in Manipur to set ball rolling, particularly in dealing with a critical projects like Imphal - Jiribam national highway which is lifeline of Manipur, although the onus of providing assistance lies with the central government. The question is why and how the congress govt in Manipur has failed to make any genuine effort to sustain or maintain such life line of Manipur over the last 14 & half years of governance in Manipur. The

present condition of highway in question simply demonstrates the reduntants as well as inability of congress govt to make the Imphal Jiribam highway in all weather road.

The worse part of the story is neither Chief Minister nor Dy CM of Manipur had ever travel on this important national highway over the last 14 years, despite the untold miseries of the people and huge & cry from different quarter of the civil society. The way one Ranjit try to throw the blame on BJP is quite misleading and simply out of place.

It would be worthwhile to place on record that BJP govt at the centre under Prime Minister Shri Modi Ji has already set up an Empower Committee on Connectivity under DoNER with a focus on removing the communication and transportation bottleneck in the intire North East Region in the time bound manner in deed an unprecedented NER Centric initiative of BJP govt at Delhi over and above. Dr Jitendra Honb'le Union Minister DoNER has been assigned special responsibilities to oversee the connectivity infrastructure projects in the region.

However, on the issue of recognition of the 1313 Rongmeis, the NGBF reiterated that those 1313 individuals of Rongmei community, who had settled prior to 1963 in the present state of Nagaland, or immediate descendants of these settlers, were indigenous to the state of Nagaland as per Government notification of 1977.

Thailand's King Bhumibol passes away

Petaling Jaya, Oct 14: Thailand's King Bhumibol Adulyadej has passed away, according to a statement from the palace. The palace announced that King Bhumibol, aged 88, passed away at 3:52pm (4:52pm Malaysian time) Thursday. He was the world's longest-reigning monarch, and was on the throne since 1946, a total of 70 years. Thailand's national legislative assembly will meet at 9pm (10pm Malaysian time) and members have been asked to wear black ties. Earlier in the day, hundreds of people gathered at a Bangkok hospital where the King was being treated. Thai Prime Minister Prayuth Chan-ocha cancelled an evening engagement on Thursday as well as his attendance at a summit in Goa, India, on Sunday without giving a reason. On Wednesday, the palace issued a statement saying that the king's health had "overall not yet stabilised" and that he was on a ventilator and battling a new infection. He had gone into an unstable condition after receiving haemodialysis treatment. All four of the king's children, including Thai crown prince Maha Vajiralongkorn, visited the hospital on Thursday and Wednesday. The king is seen as a unifying figure in Thailand. His health,



which is watched closely, is a sensitive subject. In addition to this, strict lese-majeste laws mean public discussion of his health and any succession plans are punishable by jail terms. As speculation of the king's ill-health spread, the Thai government urged jittery stock investors to ignore rumours fearing a declining stock market.

President of India condoles

New Delhi, Oct 14: The President of India, Shri Pranab Mukherjee has condoled the passing away of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej of Thailand. In his tweets, the President said, "Heartfelt condolences on the sad demise of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej of Thailand. People of India share the sorrow and grief of the people of Thailand".

Meanwhile, Thai Prime Minister Prayuth Chan-ocha said on Thursday that an heir to King Bhumibol Adulyadej, who died earlier in the day, has been designated since 2002 and that the government would inform parliament of the choice. "The government will inform the National Legislative Assembly that His Majesty the King has already designated his heir," Prayuth said in a televised address. The assembly is due to hold a special session later on Thursday. Prayuth urged Thais to love one another and protect "the father's land."
