AMUCO terms TR Zeliang visit as a mission to end Manipuri generation

Imphal, Oct 19: President of the All Manipur United Club Organisation (AMUCO) Ph Deban Sharma has term the visit of Nagaland Chief Minister TR Zeliang to Manipur for attending the 1st Conference of the Naga Village Authority at Yaikongpao in Senapati district as a journey to disintegrate the communal harmony among the various communities of the state. In a meeting with media persons, Ph Deban said that TR Zeliang is a person who even distort integrity of the Naga Community. It was at his time that the Naga HOHO was distorted. His journey to Manipur is nothing but to distort the integrity of the people and to spew poison among the various communities of the state, the AMUCO President said. On the other hand the AMUCO leader question the hidden agenda behind the boycotting of Chief Minister Okram Ibobi who was to visit Ukhrul for inauguration of the 100 bedded District hospital and welcoming Nagaland

Chief minister as chief guest to a programme organized for distorting the integrity of the state. The AMUCO president also targeted the Nagaland Chief Minister for trying to cross boundary when he himself is not capable of solving the problem of his own state. Deban was referring to the demand by the Eastern Nagaland Body where they demand a separate Union Territory by segregating the portion from the state of Nagaland. When the Nagaland Chief Minister cannot clean his own state how could one accept or agree that he will make a better place when Manipur is far better than his state. Reacting to the statement of the Union Home Minister Rajnath Singh AMUCO President Deban said that before any conclusion is brought between the NSCN-IM and the Government of India, the content of the agreement should be let known the people of the state or else there is no guarantee to the outcome.

Yaikhongpao declarations support Framework agreement; vow to protect sovereignty of South Nagalim

Imphal, Oct 19: A day after Union Home Minister Rajnath Singh had stated that the framework agreement signed between the NSCN-IM and the Government of India on August 3 last year has reached the final stage, United Naga Council (UNC) today organized 1st Conference of the Naga Village Authority at Yaikongpao in Senapati district today. The conference, first of its kind has adopted resolution which advocated recognition of Naga's Ancestral land which they term it as Southern Nagaland. T. R Zeliang, Chief Minister Nagaland Chief, Yitachu,

Education Minister of Nagaland and K G Kenye, Rajya Sabha MP attended the conference as dignitaries. Attended by village chiefs and representatives from around 800 villages from the so called Naga areas of Manipur, the conference adopted a five point declarations including stand to support the NSCN-IM and GoI peace settlement, protection of the Naga ancestral land South Nagaland and also to support the Naga People's Front (NPF) in the upcoming 11th Manipur Legislative Assembly Election. Speaking on the occasion

Chief Minister TR Zeliang called on the people to stand together to protect the right of the Naga people and its ancestral land. "Nagas (in Manipur) were independent people and were never under any rule of the Meitei King and we have every right to protect the sovereignty of the Nagaland", Zeliang the CM, who has been declared by the state government said. The Nagaland Chief Minister also slammed the Manipur Government for passing the 3 ILPS related Bills by the state Assembly terming it is an act against the interest of the tribal people.

UCM slams state Govt for announcing Nagaland CM as state guest

Imphal Oct 19: President of the United Committee Manipur (UCM), Elangbam Johnson today question the state government for declaring Nagaland Chief Minister TR Zeliang who had come to the state for attending meeting to poison hatred feeling among the various communities of the state. "Motive of the UNC for organizing the 1st Conference of the Naga Village Authority at Yaikongpao, Senapati today is known by each and every Manipuri and why should the state government declared as state guest to the person who come to distort the integrity of the state", Johnson said while speaking to a group of media persons at its head quarter. The UCM president also hinted possible conspiracy between the Okram Ibobi Singh led Congress government and those who are engineering all sort of strategy to distort the integrity of the state. Johnson further warned both the center and state government to remember what had happen in June 2000 at which 18 precious lives had sacrificed for the protection of

the state boundary. The UC*M president also questioned the government of Manipur whether it has hand in organizing the conference whose main agenda to distort the territorial boundary of the state. "Every people of Manipur knows that United Naga Council (UNC) is an organization which has been working all sort of activities to distort the integrity of the state under the whims of the NSCN-IM", Johnson added. He further said that even though the center said that the cease fire between the government of India and the NSCN-IM is confined to the state of Nagaland only people have seen the cadres of the NSCN-IM opening operating inside the territory of Manipur by setting up camps which are known to the security forces as well as other state government machineries. "Why Chief Minister Okram Ibobi is silent even after knowing that such camp exists inside the territory of Manipur? Why the state government is not taking up any action when the outfit openly celebrated its Raising day inside the territory of Manipur?", Johnson said.

Joykumar says no bomb at his residence

She said India with its experiences can help Myanmar's endeavours in all key areas.

Protest staged against bomb attack at Khuman Lampak ISBT

Imphal, Oct 19: Locals of Tangkhul Avenue of Chingmeirong staged a sit in protest in front of Kuman Lampak ISBT against the grenade attack at the residence of Clemant Singlei (68) on 17/10/2016 at 6.45 pm by unidentified persons at which 3 women including a minor girl were seriously injured. The sit in protest was jointly organized by Women Action for Development, Women Welfare, Rongmee Lu Phuum, Tangkhul Shinaolung, Tangkhul Avenue Village Authority and Meira Paibi. Speaking to the media person, president of Meira paibi Leishiwon Keishing said that

the locals of and CSO strongly condemn the bomb attack at the public place in which 3 women including a minor were seriously injured. She said that most of residents of the area are facing financially problem and backward people. The injured people were belonged to poor family. They were coming from interior hill district to make a living and also to study by staying at rented houses. One woman was discharged while the remaining two is in ICU. She further asked who is going to help for their medical fees as their poor family can't able to provide. She further appeals to the arm group not to repeat such incident to the local area.

Manipur Maoist claims bomb at former DGP's residence

Imphal, Oct 19: Rebel group Maoist Communist Party, Manipur has claimed responsibility to the placing of bomb at the residence of former DGP Y. Joykumar at his Naoremthong residence yesterday morning. In a claimed letter, sent through email, the rebel group said that the bomb was planted by the special unit of Urban Guerilla of the Maoist Communist Party Manipur. The outfit blamed the former top cop for murdering many Manipuris in the name of counter insurgency.

The statement said that the bomb was placed according to a resolution adopted last year to strike any ex-serviceman of Indian security forces who involved in the works and services of Manipuri people in general.
