## Oil tanker trucks drivers sustain bullet injury in militants attack at NH-2 of Kangpokpi area

tanker drivers who were on their way towards Dimapur were seriously wounded after armed miscreants fired upon towards them at NH -2 in between Changoubung and Kangpokpi at around 5.40 am

This usual nature of identification of the alleged accused and victims on the line of community in the state obviously led to a presumption that the rape was being perpetuated by Meitei upon Hills thereby side lining the important legal question involved on juvenile. Thus, there lies a question on how well are we caring and protecting our younger generation who are found in

accepted principle any individual who are below the age of 18 years are treated as a "child". After the popular outcry to reduce the age of criminal responsibility to 16 years post the isolatedNirbhaya Case,a new Juvenile Justice (Careand Protection of Children), 2015,

existing juvenile law. The new law on juvenile allows children between 16 and 18 years alleged to have committed "heinous offences" to be tried and sentenced as adult. According to the new JJ Act 'heinous offences' as those "for which the minimum punishment under the Indian Penal Code (IPC) or any other law for the time being in force is imprisonment for seven years or more." The new JJ Act has been widely criticized by the rights activist across the country stating the fact that it completely destroys the rehabilitative principle by adopting a retributive approach.

In the present alleged gang rape, the publications of identities of all the accused by the state media housesat first and later claimed of juveniles by families of the accused led to appear at public an institutional attempt to cover up. This unethical practice of media further led an NGO instances in the past, criminals were freed in the state on the pretext of juveniles.Many people including women activists, journalists etc. have been asserting to discard the age proof given by the school and insisting medical test for verifying the age of the accused in the present case.In fact Justice K. S. Radhakrishnan and A. K. Sikri of the Supreme Court of India held that school certificate to be used as age proof of iuvenile when the court allowed in an appeal brought forward by RanjeetGoswami who was challenging the Madhya Pradesh High Court verdict (2013).This is an outcome to the question if an accused is a juvenile or not. The Supreme Court held that an authentic school leaving certificate should be considered instead of a medical examination to conform the age of the juvenile. (Contd. on page 2)

# Cyclonic storm destroys many houses, uprooted trees, electric poles in Imphal

IT News Imphal, April 30: Several houses, trees, electric poles, wires were damaged and uprooted leaving many people injured in the cyclonic storm which hit the capital city at around midnight yesterday. The heavy storm also blew away roofs of many houses in the Imphal valley including the rooftop of Imphal Times (Daily evening English newspaper). Houses built near the river side suffered the most in the storm. The storm was strong that, many big tress were rooted causing inconveniences to the commuters.

At Singjamei, long HD power line pole uprooted and laid along with the wires at the Singjamei Bridge causing inconveniences to the public, at Keisamthong Irompukhri Mapal, a house crush after an iron sheet felt on the rooftop and collapsed inside the house but fortunately no one was

The recent alleged rape of two minor girls by seven youths in Imphal on 14th April, has triggered widespread anger demanding death penalty of all the accused. A special court under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 has remanded the only adult accused to judicial custody while six other accused who are reported to be juveniles are still at juvenile home.
