Top US diplomat to travel to India, Pakistan

diplomat will travel to India and Pakistan later this month to discuss Americas relations with South Asia as the Trump administration reviews its Afghanistan policy to include a

regional perspective. Alice Wells, Acting Assistant Secretary of State for South and Central Asian Affairs and Acting Special Representative for Afghanistan and Pakistan, will travel to New Delhi and Islamabad on her introductory trip to the region from July 30 to August 8, a statement said

"She will meet with government officials, thought leaders, and business executives to discuss US relations with the region," the State Department said. Wells will also meet with Embassy staff to learn more about their efforts to advance US

prosperity and security across the region, the statement added. Her trip assumes significance as the US wants to deal with the ongoing crisis in Afghanistan from a regional perspective in its new strategy for the country to involve its neighbours such as Iran, Pakistan and India. PTI LKJ NSA

New Delhi, July 28: Defence of strategic partnerships in defence Minister Arun Jaitley has said that enough arms and ammunitions are sector. The Ministere said, the policy is available in the country to face any

intended to institutionalise transparent, objective and functional mechanism to encourage broader participation of the private sector in manufacture of major defence platforms and equipments He said, indigenous contribution in the production of arms and ammunitions have increased many folds. The Minister said, government has initiated move for modernisation of state owned ordinance factories and has taken measures to increase their

production capacities. Replying to supplementaries, Minister of State of Defence Subhash Bhamre said that no state owned ordinance factory will be closed down and no worker will face unemployment. He said, 25 private sector factories have been identified to engage for production of arms and ammunitions for defence forces He said, eight items including aircraft submarines, helicopters and armoured vehicles will be produced from identified private sector Indian companies.

Netaji didn't die in air crash, says secret French report

Chennai, July 28: How did Subhas Chandra Bose die? To find the answer, the Indian government had appointed three commissions. The ah Nawaz Committee (1956) and Khosla Commission (1970) said that Bose died in an air crash on August 18, 1945 at Taihoku airport in Japanese-occupied Taipei, while the Mukherjee Commission (1999) concluded that he did not die in an air-crash. The government, however, rejected the findings of the Mukherjee Commission. But that didn't stop scholars from dwelling deep to find the truth. Paris-based historian J B P More,

who recently stumbled upon a brief French secret service report dated December 11, 1947 at the National Archives of France, has come up with a finding that Bose didn't die in an air crash and was still alive in 1947.

"It is not stated in the document that Subhas Chandra Bose died in the air crash in Taiwan. Instead, it is reported that Bose's present whereabouts were unknown as late as December 1947, which again implies that the French did not buy the theory that Bose died in the air-crash on August 18, 1945," said More, who teaches at the Institut des Hautes Etudes Economiques et Commerciales, Paris. The gist of the matter for the

French secret service, according to More, is that Bose did not die in the air crash on August 18, 1945, as commonly held. "But he escaped from Indochina alive and his whereabouts were unknown as late as December 11, 1947, as reported in the secret document. This implies that he was alive somewhere but not dead in 1947," implies that he was

said More, quoting the report written for the "Haut Commisariat de France for Indochina "SDECE Indochinese Base BCRI No. 41283 csah Ex No. 616, under the title: "Archival Information on Subhas Chandra Bose." "In this report, it is clearly stated that he was the exchief of the Indian Independence League and a member of Hikari Kikan, a Japanese organisation. It is further stated clearly that he escaped from Indochina, though it does not state how." he said.

The British and the Japanese too declared that Bose died in an air crash after he took off from Saigon on his way to Tokyo. But the French government had always been silent on the issue, though Vietnam/ Indochina was a French colony during the 1940s. So the findings of More attain significance.
