

IED blast at AR check post kills jawan, injures two other

Imphal, June 30 : A jawan of the Assam Rifles was killed and two of his compatriots were injured when unidentified persons detonated a powerful IED at a check post manned by the paramilitary personnel early this morning. According to sources the fatal explosion took place at around 7.20 am in very close vicinity of the security check point of 27 AR F-Coy Lambui post which falls under the jurisdiction of Shangkak police station in Ukhrul district. The deceased was identified as rifleman Biju Sorupuar of Lathow village in North Lakhimpur district of Assam while the two injured were identified as havildar Yash Pal from Hajalta village in Udampur district in Jammu and Kashmir and rifleman Nihar Ranjan Das of Gopea village in Kendra Para district of Odhisha. The area was immediately cordoned off by security forces and no civilian access was allowed for some time. Details of the incident are still awaited.

All is set to launch GST PM to unveil new tax regime in central hall of Parliament at midnight tonight

New Delhi, June 30 : All preparations are in place for the launch of nationwide Goods and Services Tax tonight. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will unveil the new tax regime at a function in Central Hall of Parliament at midnight tonight. The new tax regime replaces more than a dozen state and central levies built up over

seven decades, with a one national GST unifying the country's economy and over 100 crore people into a common market. Janata Dal United has said it will attend the midnight session of parliament on GST rollout. Bihar Commercial taxes Minister Bijendra Prasad Yadav will represent the state at the GST launch function in Delhi. Chief Minister Nitish

Kumar said he and his party are supporting GST from the beginning. Mr. Kumar said consumer states like Bihar will be benefited more from GST. Finance Minister Arun Jaitley has made a last minute appeal to the opposition to reconsider their decision saying the landmark indirect tax reform was a result of a joint decision and they cannot run away from it now.

Youth arrested for sending lewd images, messages

Imphal, June 30 : Cyber Crime Unit, Imphal West and Bishnupur District Police arrested a youth for sending lewd messages and pictures to a woman after learning about her phone number from her facebook page. According to reports, the complainant who is a resident of Bamon Kampu Mayai Leikai reported to Irlibung police station on April 7 last that an unknown person who claimed to be Rakesh from Nambol had been sending her obscene messages and whatsapp video with obscene contents to her mobile. The officer-in-charge of Irlibung PS forwarded the complaint to cyber crime unit of the district for inquiry and the latter found during the

course of the probe that the act was perpetrated by a 24-year-old youth from Bishnupur Yengkhom Leikai, Ward No 11, Ningthoujam Lokhendro. He disclosed that he got the mobile number of the woman from her Facebook information. He had reportedly exhibited his private parts to her through whatsapp video calls and sent vulgar messages. He was arrested thereafter by a team of the cyber crime unit led by K Abhijeet and Bishnupur police under the supervision of senior SP of Imphal West from his residence during which a mobile handset and two SIM cards used in the commission of the crime was recovered. The case has been handed over to Irlibung police station for further investigation.

Connectivity matters in GST implementation

The nation is all set to roll out the new tax regime Goods and Services Tax (GST) from midnight today. Much has been debated about the merits and demerits of the new tax regime. Some big companies particularly those in textile trades are not happy but overall many applaud the new move of the center. Big states which are having multiple factories and companies seems to be not happy but for smaller states like Manipur which lacks industries and factories have reason to be smile, because the new tax regime will be benefitted to consumer state. From midnight today, all form of taxes including VAT will be abolished and there will be no check post in Highways for tax entries. These will reduce the inconveniences of transporters. State Government will be benefitted from every goods that are being consumed by the state. Another advantage of the GST for the state of Manipur is that the government may be able to control the quality of the goods transported in the state. With the implementation of the GST regime any wholesalers, retailers that are not registered in the GST will not be able to procure their goods. So, systematic procurement of goods will be necessary once the GST come into force that means wholesalers or retailers will show more concerned to the quality of the goods.

In the recent days there are some apprehensions among the handloom weavers as well as those running fermented fish with the coming of the GST. But it has been clearly stated that in handloom products GST will not be applied until the products are materialised. For those doing the Fermented fish business the GST will benefit them in the long run.

Even though GST is more like a boon for consumer state like Manipur, various factors might sabotage the implementation process. One biggest challenges face by the Taxation authority is the connectivity issue as well as lack of proper knowledge about internet among the retailers and the wholesalers. All process of GST will be done in internet only and there will be no paper work. For submitting documents a wholesaler or the retailer or those running industries need high internet connectivity which is not available in the state of Manipur due to negligence from the part of BSNL. There are other networks like airtel, vodaphone etc. but all these networks depends on BSNL. The irregularities in the network by the BSNL authority are one apprehension on the success of GST. There is also likely that the revenue of the state decline with the implementation of the GST, but a provision in the GST which assures assistance from the Center if in case the revenue is reduced solved the matters. The nation is ready, the state is ready let's hope the BSNL too is ready for successful implementation of the GST.
