Former United Nations Secretary-General, Kofi Annan has died at age 80

Former secretary general of the United Nations, Kofi Annan passed away on Saturday morning. Annan, a Nobel Peace Prize winner has died at the ripe old age of 80 years. He was born in Ghana in 1938 and served as the seventh Secretary General of UN from 1997 to 2006. Annan was the first among others to rise from within the ranks of the United Nations staff. Annan was the first black African to take up the role of the world's top diplomat. He had also served as the UN special envoy for Syria, leading efforts to find a peaceful solution to the conflict. Annan was a member of The

Elders, a group of world leaders, founded in 2007, works for human rights. He became the Chairman of the group in 2013. The UN

Mr Annan died in the early hours of Saturday in Switzerland after a short illness, according to a statement issued by his

family. The Nobel Peace Laureate was the seventh Secretary-General of the United Nations from January 1997 to December 2006, and became the first black African man to

take on the top job as the world's top diplomat. He was founder and Chairman

of the Kofi Annan Foundation, which issued a statement on social media, saying: "It is with immense sadness that the Annan family and the Kofi Annan Foundation announce that Kofi Annan, former Secretary General of the United Nations and Nobel Peace Laureate passed away peacefully on Saturday 18th August after a short illness..."

"The prime minister announced a financial assistance of Rs 500 crore to the state. This is in addition to Rs 100 crore announced by Home Minister Rajnath Singh on August 12," it said

After a high-level review meeting in Kochi, the prime minister made an aerial assessment of the damage caused due to floods in some of the affected areas of the southern state
