The BJP has worked out seat-sharing arrangement with Bihar ally Lok Janshakti Party with the latter expected to contest five Lok Sabha seats in the state, one seat in either Uttar Pradesh or Jharkhand and its president Ram Vilas Paswan likely to be given a berth in the Rajya Sabha.

According to sources, the Nitish Kumar's Janata Dal (United) and the BJP will contest on 17 seats each in Bihar. Sources added that an announcement to the effect may be made as early as Saturday.

The deal was clinched after Ram Vilas Paswan, who is also a Union minister, and his son Chirag Paswan met BJP leader Arun Jaitley. Chirag, who has been vocal in airing his party's differences with the BJP, told reporters that talks were on and claimed there were other issues besides sharing of seats.

Sources later said differences between the two parties have been

BJP president Amit Shah had earlier announced that his party and its key ally JD(U) will be contesting equal number of seats in the politically crucial state where the BJP-led NDA had won 31 seats in 2014. The deployment of

The deployment of Jaitley, an old Bihar hand in the party with friendly relations with leaders of different parties, by the BJP to buy truce with the LJP underscores the importance the saffron party has attached to party has attached to continuing its alliance with Paswan's party, which enjoys strong influence among Dalits. Top BJP leaders, including its president Shah and Jaitley, had held an hour-long meeting with LJP chief Ram Vilas Paswan and his son Thursday to resolve differences

Chirag Paswan had earlier written a letter to Jaitley asking him to explain what benefits demonetisation brought to the country.

Keiriwal Demands MLA Alka Lamba's Resignation From AAP Over Rajiv Gandhi Bharat Ratna Row

Delhi legislator Alka Lamba was asked to resign from the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) on Friday, hours after the party denied passing a state assembly resolution apparently aimed at withdrawing late Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi's Bharat Ratna over his failure to curb the 1984 anti-

Sikh riots.
The AAP MLA said she will tender her resignation as "demanded" by Delhi Chief Minister Arvind
Kejriwal for not
supporting a
resolution in the

on Friday adopted a resolution in which it was demanded that the Bharat Ratna awarded to Rajiv Gandhi be withdrawn, but the AAP swiftly distanced itself from the

The matter became a a major crisis, with Lamba alleging she was "put under pressure" to support the resolution, which she resisted and boycotted.

Lamba said she was ready to face "any consequences" and claimed she spoke to AAP supremo and CM Keiriwal who, she said. asked her to resign as MLA. "I am ready to do

so", she said. The Chandni Chowk MLA said she was not happy with the demand to take back Bharat Ratna from Gandhi and staged a walkout in

protest.
Interestingly, the AAP later distanced itself from the resolution. "After I staged a walkout, I got a message from the chief minister to tender my a party ticket. I will tender my resignation as demanded by the party," the former Youth Congress leader said. In a tweet, she said, "I was asked to support the resolution demanding taking back the Bharat Ratna awarded to former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi. Since I didn't agree to this, I staged a walk out. I am ready to accept whatever punishment

Aide of Kashmir's most wanted Terrorist among 6 killed in J&K's Pulwama

In a major boost to antiterror operation, security forces have killed six terrorists in a gunfight in Jammu and Kashmir's Pulwama district. An aide of Zakir Moosa, one of Kashmir's most wanted terrorist, was also killed in the operation.
The encounter was

launched in Arampora village in Awantipora area of the south Kashmir district

a cordon and search operation in the area following specific

intelligence input about the presence of terrorists Police said as the forces

were conducting searches, terrorists fired upon them, triggering the encounter.

Huge quantity of arms and ammunition have been recovered from the

spot, police said. A former Hizbul Mujahideen commander, Zakir Moosa is the head of al Qaeda-linked group Ansar Ghazwat-ul Hind, which is said to have links to Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM). He is one of the most wanted terrorists who are currently

In November, Punjab was put on high alert after he was spotted near Amritsar. Posters of Zakir Moosa were put up across the state following inputs that he along with seven members of the terror outfit Jaish-e-Mohammed were believed to be sighted in Ferozepur. Earlier that month, the Punjab Police arrested two students associated with his terrorist organisation connection with Maqsudan Police Station hand-grenade blasts case of September 14.
