

Unnao rape case: CBI source reveals cover up; victim demands death penalty for Kuldeep Singh Sengar

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) probing the political-sensitive Unnao gang-rape case has reportedly confirmed rape charges against Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar. The probe agency corroborated the survivor's charge that BJP MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar raped her at his home, while his female accomplice, Shashi Singh, stood guard outside the room. "I demand death penalty for BJP MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar for raping me and for the murder of my father," said the victim. The family of the victim has demand protection so that they can give the statement before the court fearlessly. Citing sources, a report also said that the local police kept the MLA and some other accused out of the FIR filed on June 20 as well as the chargesheet filed later. "In connivance with the



accused persons, the police also delayed the girl's medical examination and didn't send the vaginal swab or her clothes to the forensic laboratory," said the officer. However, in response to media queries related to a news item published in a national daily, the CBI stated that investigation in Unnao case is still continuing. "CBI has not given any update/conclusion/views with respect to the case to any

mediaperson. All such stories related to Unnao case published/broadcast in the media recently are purely speculative," the probe agency state. Last week, after the victim's family made an appeal in the Allahabad High Court, Sengar was shifted from the Unnao Jail to Sitapur Jail. In February, the girl's family had moved the court, seeking to include the MLA's name in

the case. Subsequently, the victim's father was booked by the police under the Arms Act on April 3 and put in jail on April 5. Frustrated with the alleged police inaction and coercion from influential people, the victim attempted self-immolation in front of Chief Minister Adityanath's residence on April 8. The next day, her father died in jail with the post-mortem examination report suggesting serious injuries on his body. Sengar, a four-time MLA, enjoys an immense clout, cutting across party lines, in rural areas of Unnao district, a semi-urban area about 70 km from Lucknow.

Karnataka prepares for assembly polls on tomorrow after fierce campaigning ended last evening

Elaborate security arrangements have been made to ensure free and fair Assembly elections in Karnataka tomorrow. The Election Commission has issued guidelines to political parties and media for strict compliance with the Model code of conduct till the election is over. The EC has also imposed the ban on public opinion programmes in the media till the voting is over. AIR correspondent reports, over one lakh 40 thousand security personnel are deployed to ensure peaceful polling. The DG-IGP of police Neelamani Raju informed media persons in Bengaluru today, that 585 companies of paramilitary forces are deployed in 20,826 polling

stations, which includes 12001 critical booths. She said that the deployed forces include Karnataka civil and armed police forces, Home Guards and Karnataka Industrial Security force. Besides civil and armed police forces from other states and central forces including BSF, ITBP, CISF, Rapid Action Force are also being deployed and for the first time personnel are drawn from Forest department. The DG informed that no Naxal movements are detected and no call for poll ban is given by them. A total of 2636 candidates are in the fray for election to 223 of 224 assembly seats, out of which 617 are women. BJP has fielded 223 candidates while Congress has fielded 222 candidates. JD (S) is contesting in 201 constituencies. The young voters' size has

also doubled compared to the last assembly elections in the state. The election in Jayanagar Assembly constituency has been postponed following the death of BJP candidate B N Vijay Kumar. The counting of votes will take place on 15th May.

EAM Sushma Swaraj meets Myanmar's State Counsellor Aung San Suu Kyi

External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj today met Myanmar's State Counsellor and Foreign Minister Aung San Suu Kyi at Nay Pyi Taw on the second day of her visit to the neighbouring country.

In a tweet, MEA spokesperson, Raveesh Kumar said, discussion between the two leaders focused on strengthening bilateral relations across different sectors. Seven agreements were also signed between the two countries.

Mrs Swaraj also met the Commander-in-Chief of the Myanmar Armed forces, Senior General Min Aung Hlaing. Earlier, she met Myanmar President U Win Myint. Mrs Swaraj reached Myanmar yesterday on a two day visit to boost bilateral ties. Myanmar is a key partner in India's Act East Policy. It is India's strategic neighbour and shares a 1,640 km border with a number of northeastern states.

United States imposes sanctions on six Iranian people and three companies

The United States has imposed sanctions on six Iranian people and three companies, for having ties with Iran's elite military force. Treasury Secretary, Steven Mnuchin said in a statement that the penalties targeted those who had funnelled millions of dollars to Iran's military. He said the Iranian regime and its Central Bank have abused access to entities in the UAE to acquire US dollars to fund Iran's elite military force, the

Revolutionary Guard Corps. The Treasury Department said US individuals and entities will be barred from doing business with them. US President, Donald Trump yesterday said at a rally in the state of Indiana that the US cannot allow Iran to have nuclear weapons. The new penalties come just two days after Trump pulled the US out of the Iran nuclear deal and pledged to ramp up pressure on Tehran. The 2015 agreement curbed Iran's nuclear activities in return for the lifting of UN, US and EU sanctions.

UN disarmament chief says efforts to disarm North Korea will not be easy

The United Nations disarmament chief said efforts to disarm North Korea will not be easy. Speaking to Japanese high school students in New York, the UN Under-Secretary-General and High Representative for Disarmament Affairs, Izumi Nakamitsu said denuclearizing North Korea meant not just dismantling existing nuclear weapons but complete and irreversible denuclearization. She said the United Nations is weighing what role it can play in this effort by collecting information and exchanging views with the United States. She said North Korea probably also possesses chemical and biological weapons. She also said the US's summit with the North on June 12th in Singapore, will be the start of a very difficult task, never before experienced by the international community.
