Convener of the JAC, Somo said that the JAC will not accept the dead body until an agreement is reached between the government and the JAC.

CM briefs centre on state finances

Chief Minister N. Biren Singh met the Union Finance Minister and senior Ministry officials and detailed discussions were held on various issues concerning the State's finances. In the meeting,

Chief Minister apprised the Ministry of the State's financial position and health. The meeting was positive. The Finance Minister expressed understanding of the State's concerns. Day before yesterday, the Chief Minister met officials of the PMO and discussed about the

developmental needs of the state and the priorities being accorded to various sectors. PMO officials expressed their satisfaction on the speedy progress achieved against time bound targets of important projects.

During the discussions, Chief Minister requested Finance Minister and PMO for assistance for taking up more Ina Markets, Thoubal Project, State Guest House, Loktak Livelihood Mission and some other important projects. An amount of about Rs. 2600 crore has been recommended for taking up drinking water schemes in the state by the Water Resource Ministry, Ministry of External Affairs, MHA, Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation and NITI Ayog. Finance Minister assured of quick action for recommending assistance from the New Development Bank. Chief Minister also met the Union Defence Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman. She agreed to grace the Manipur Sangai Festival 2018 as the Chief Guest on its opening ceremony.

Later Sotai Kri led 16 members Arunachal team along with some state SBM functionaries left for Moreh.

It may be worth mentioning here that Sikkim becomes India's first ODF state in India in 2008. Arunachal Pradesh achieved ODF on December 31 last year while Manipur was declared as 23rd ODF state on October 2, 2018. It may worth mentioning here that SBM was launched in October 2014 by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, setting October 2, 2019 as the deadline. The day marks 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
