SC refuse complete ban on fire crackers not adhering to the green

Agency New Delhi, Oct. 23

The Supreme Court on Tuesday refused to order a complete ban on firecrackers and permitted only green firecrackers with reduced emission and decibel levels during all religious festivals. A bench of Justice AK Sikri and Justice Ashok Bhushan prohibited the bursting of firecrackers norms that would apply all the year round. The rules would not only be applicable to Diwali but New Year and marriage festivities as well. A plea had sought a ban on the manufacture and sale of firecrackers across

the country to curb air pollution. Firecrackers

manufacturers had earlier told the court that there should be no complete ban on the use of firecrackers but should be strictly regulated. They had argued that crackers are not the sole reason for an increase in air

pollution. The SC had reserved its verdict in this regard on August 28. It had said that there was a need to consider all aspects, consider all aspects, including the right to health of more than 1.3 billion people in the country.
