

# Filing of nominations for 3rd phase of LS polls ends today

New Delhi April 04,**

Filing of nominations for the third phase of Lok Sabha elections will end on Thursday evening. The scrutiny of nominations will take place on Friday and 8 April is the last date for withdrawal of candidature.

115 seats, spread over 12 States and two Union Territories, will go to polls in this phase on the 23rd of April.

All parliamentary constituencies of Gujarat, Goa, Kerala, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu will go to polls in the third phase. Besides this, voting will also take place for 14 seats each in Maharashtra and Karnataka, ten in Uttar Pradesh, seven in Chhattisgarh, six in Odisha, five each in Bihar and West Bengal, four in Assam, and one seat in

Jammu and Kashmir in this phase. Congress President Rahul Gandhi filed his nomination from Kerala's Wayanad parliamentary constituency Thursday. Mr Gandhi will also be contesting the Amethi Lok Sabha seat in Uttar Pradesh. In Gujarat, 133 candidates filed their nominations for the third phase of 26 Lok Sabha seats on the penultimate day of filing of nomination papers yesterday. With this, the total number of nominations filed for this phase has gone up to 260. In Assam, 38 nomination papers have been filed for the third phase of general elections. The four constituencies that will go to polls in this phase include Guwahati, Dhubri, Barpeta, and Kokrajhar. Maximum 12 candidates filed nomination papers for Guwahati constituency. RLSP Chief

In Bihar, 30 candidates filed their nominations for the third phase of Lok Sabha polls yesterday. With this, the total nominations for this phase in the state have reached 57. Constituencies going to the polls in this phase include Jhanjharpur, Supaul, Araria, Madhepura, and Khagaria. Meanwhile, Congress today released a list of two candidates for Lok Sabha polls in Gujarat. Party has fielded Babubhai Kataria from Dahod and Sherkhan Abdul Shakur Pathan from Bharuch seat. BJP has released a list of one candidate for Lok Sabha elections. The party has fielded HS Patel from Ahmedabad East constituency in Gujarat. Rashtriya Lok Samta Party (RLSP) released the names of remaining four candidates. RLSP Chief

Upendra Kushwaha will contest from two constituencies — Ujjiarpur and Karakat. BJP president Amit Shah will address public meetings at Narasaraopet and Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh. Union Textiles Minister and BJP leader Smriti Irani will begin a two-day visit to Amethi today. Mrs Irani will address a Kisan Rally in Jamshedpur under the Amethi parliamentary constituency. Mrs Irani is the BJP candidate for Amethi, where she is pitted against Congress President Rahul Gandhi. Rahul Gandhi will also address an election rally at Nagpur in Maharashtra. Along with the Lok Sabha polls, 42 seats of Odisha assembly will also go to polls in the third phase. In this phase, by-polls will also be held for three assembly constituencies of Goa and four assembly seats in Gujarat.

## Rahul Gandhi Files Nomination From Wayanad .....



The Congress chief was received at the airport by former Kerala chief minister Oommen Chandy and other leaders of the Congress-led alliance in the state. Rahul Gandhi and Priyanka Gandhi spent the night at a guest house in Kozhikode.

The Congress president's decision to contest from a second seat bolstered the BJP's charge that Rahul Gandhi is "running away" because he is unsure of his prospects in Amethi, where he has been challenged by Union Minister Smriti Irani for the second time.

On Tuesday, he explained

that he was fighting from

Wayanad because: "South India feels hostility from Narendra Modi; I wanted to send message that I am standing with you."

He was responding to PM Modi saying at a rally in Maharashtra that the Congress was "afraid" because it had insulted Hindus by using the term "Hindu terror" and knew it would be punished by the community. He implied that was the reason why Rahul Gandhi had decided to contest in Wayanad, where "the majority is in a minority".

Wayanad, a relatively backward region, is home

to Kerala's largest tribal population. Eighteen per cent of the district's vote share is that of tribals.

The Congress says by choosing Wayanad, Rahul Gandhi will be contesting from a seat that, in a way, represents three southern states. Wayanad shares borders with Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

The NDA coalition has fielded Thushar Vellappally of the Bharat Dharm Jana Sena to take on the Congress president.

Wayanad will vote on April 23 and Amethi on May 6. The counting of votes in the staggered national election will be held on May 23.
