



Government fully Committed to uphold dignity and Honour of Women : Chief Minister

Remembering the brave Mothers of Manipur who fought against the mighty British, the State level 'Nupee Lan Day, 2019' was observed at Nupee Lan Memorial Complex, Imphal today. On the occasion, Chief Minister N. Biren Singh and Deputy Chief Minister Y. Joykumar graced as Chief Guest and President respectively. Speaking as Chief Guest of the function, Chief Minister N. Biren Singh said that the present government is fully committed to uphold the dignity and honour of women. He mentioned that the government has established Fast Track Court to deal crimes against women to deliver justice in short period of time. Special Women Cells have been also opened in all the Police Stations of the State, he



added. Stressing out the unique qualities and talents of Manipuri women, N. Biren Singh mentioned that it is indeed a matter of pride that many Manipuri women are at the forefront in various fields in the country. In Manipur, many women hold top post of various government departments, he added. He also pointed out that Manipur topped in women ownership of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) businesses in the country. Manipur women owned 50 per cent of the MSME businesses when compared to national figure which is about 20-30 per cent, he added. The Chief Minister asserted that there is a need for another

Nupee Lan to fight against various problems prevailing in the society such as drug menace, alcoholism etc. There is rampant drug menace and alcoholism in the State and a collective effort is needed to tackle it, he added. He further appealed to all the government officials to work with commitment and dedication for bringing development in the State. Mentioning that the present venue for the Nupee Lan observation is creating certain inconveniences to the public, Chief Minister stated that the government is planning to shift the Nupial observation to another venue from next year. He maintained that the observation would be organised in grand scale by creating awareness about the essence and relevance of Nupee Lan in the present society and added that prominent women leaders from each locality would be invited to attend the observance from

next year. The State Cabinet will discuss in this regard, he added. While delivering the Presidential address, Deputy Chief Minister Y. Joykumar Singh stressed on the role of Manipuri women in Nation building. Paying tribute to all the brave mothers of Manipur, he narrated the courage of the Mothers who fought against the mighty British. He further added that we must not forget the supreme sacrifices and valour of our brave mothers. Prior to the function, Chief Minister led others in laying floral tributes to the statue of brave mothers of the State. During the observation, a play based on Nupee Lan was performed by joint artistes of Nupee Lan Memorial Association and Nupee Lal & Khongjom War Memorial Society. Cabinet Ministers, MLAs, Chief Secretary, DGP, Administrative Secretaries, top civil and police officials and others attended the function.

Anti-CAB protests intensity in Ghy: People defy curfew; Army conducts flag march

A day after the passing of the Citizenship (Amendment) Bill 2019 at Lok Sabha protest against the Bill turn hostile in Guwahati with large number of people coming on the streets shouting slogans defying curfew imposed by district administration. Situation in Guwahati as well as in other part of Assam remain tense as the protestor pain anti CAB slogan with their own bloods. At Dibrugarh protestor were charged with lathi and gun shots were heard firing by the security force to disperse the protestors. Lady protestors were even not left by male police while hitting with the lathi. As the situation is completely out of hand the Army conducts flag march in Guwahati city. Guwahati, the epicentre of

anti-CAB protests, was placed under indefinite curfew on Wednesday night while the Army was called in at four places and Assam Rifles personnel were deployed in Tripura on Wednesday as the two northeastern States plunged into chaos over the hugely emotive Bill. All Assam Student's Union has called for a protest at 11 a.m. in Guwahati. Krishak Mukti Sangram Samiti appealed to the people to come out on the road for a peaceful protest. People were on the roads in the night despite curfew. The Army conducted a flag march in the city on Thursday morning. Vehicles were stranded in various cities of Assam due to heavy blockade. Half-a dozen vehicles were burnt. The houses of the BJP and the AGP leaders were attacked in various parts of the State.

YACPIP condemn North East MPs for supporting CAB

Youths Action Committee for Protection of Indigenous People (YACPIP) expressed strong opposition to the action of the Government of India for going against the interest of the Indigenous People of North East by passing the Citizenship Amendment Bill, 2016 both in Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha beside several opposition from the people as well as the elected representatives of the people. "We fear of entering into an era of "Elected Dictatorial System" in this so call largest democratic country in the World", a statement signed by L Gulshan, President of the Committee said. The committee also expressed condemnation to the action of supporting CAB by the Member of Parliament both in Upper and

Lower house of all the state of North East besides knowing the fact that CAB will have serious impact on the Indigenous People inhabited in the region. It further condemn the action of MANPAC for fooling the people by weakening the movement of the CSOs and giving a wrong impression to the general public

which is of serious concern and a serious attention needed. YACPIP however welcome the Inner Line Permit System, but said that rejoicing at this early stage while the violence is at its peak in Tripura and Assam is not a wise step of the people of Manipur and the Government. (Contd. on Page 2)
