

Jagan Reddy sworn in as Andhra Pradesh CM today

New Delhi May 30,

YSR Congress party president YS Jagan Mohan Reddy is all set to be sworn-in as Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh today. Governor ESL Narasimhan will administer him the oath of office and secrecy at Indira Gandhi Municipal Stadium in Vijayawada at

12.23 PM.

Mr Reddy will be the second Chief Minister of bifurcated Andhra Pradesh. Telangana Chief Minister K Chandra Sekhar Rao, Bihar CM Nitish Kumar and Janasena Party Chief Pawan Kalyan are among a host of dignitaries likely to attend the swearing-in ceremony. Around 20,000 people including all MLAs, MLCs,

MPs of YSR Congress party have been invited for the ceremony. Jagan Mohan Reddy-led YSRCP swept the recently concluded Andhra Pradesh Assembly polls and bagged 151 seats in the 175 member assembly. Chandrababu-led TDP got only 23 seats, while Pawan Kalyan's Janasena got only one seat.

Normal life paralyzed due to severe heat wave in parts of country

Severe heat wave is likely to continue in Vidarbha for the next two days. Yesterday Chandrapur recorded the highest temperature with the mercury reaching 48-degree Celsius. There is no relief in sight for coming two days either in the region. The risk of sunstroke is high and therefore district administration and health

department have issued advisories. The health department has suggested avoiding long exposure to the sun during afternoon hours and avoids wearing dark colour clothes. Consuming water and fruit juice and resting in the shade during the afternoon is also recommended. According to the regional meteorological department, Very light to light rainfall occurred at isolated places over Vidarbha yesterday but it provided to relief to the

citizens. In Uttar Pradesh, people are reeling under the heat wave and high temperature. The temperature has gone beyond 44 degree Celsius in most parts of the state. Hospitals are full of the patients of Heatstroke and diarrhoea. The scorching heat has led to water scarcity in many areas especially in the Bundelkhand region where people are having a tough time beating the heat. In Banda, Orai and Hamirpur day temperature recorded

close to 47 degrees. Allahabad was the hottest place in the state yesterday with 47.6-degree temperature which was 6 degree above normal. The heatwave has left people inside their homes and streets become deserted by afternoon. In the night also People are not getting any relief because of mercury reaching 29 to 30.5 degrees. As per the metrological department, no relief is likely in coming days while many parts of the state are expected to witness extreme heat wave.

Robert Vadra appears before ED

Robert Vadra, the brother-in-law of Congress President Rahul Gandhi, appeared before the Enforcement Directorate today in connection with a money laundering case linked to purchase of alleged illegal assets abroad. Vadra reached the agency's office in New Delhi around 10:30 AM. He was summoned to depose before the investigating officer of the case where his statement will be recorded under the



Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). Vadra has appeared before the agency multiple times in the past in this case. The agency recently sought cancellation of the anticipatory bail given to Vadra and has also opposed his foreign travel. A local

court had on Wednesday reserved for Monday its order to allow Vadra to travel abroad. Last week, the Enforcement Directorate moved a Delhi court seeking cancellation of the anticipatory bail given to Vadra in this case and the Delhi High Court had then issued a notice to him seeking his response.
