Former chief of the United National Liberation Front (UNLF) RK Sanavaima also known as Meghen today broke down with tears and passion as large number of people received him at Imphal Airport which was named after his great grandfather -Bir Tikendrajit the International Airport today afternoon.

This is perhaps the first time for Meghen to appear in public in his homeland after he went underground in 1975.
